Our Pinot Noir is a perfect fit for fans of both rosé and red wines. With minimal barrel aging, the wine retains its vibrant, youthful fruit characteristics while maintaining a low tannin profile. The cool climate of the Russian River Valley, featuring fog and cool nights, shines through in the wine's refreshing acidity and fresh fruit notes. Overall, this easy-drinking and versatile red wine is an excellent choice to pair with lighter dishes.
