2021 Santino's Vineyard Pinot Noir



Description:

This wine offers inviting aromas of vanilla and ripe ruby red cherry. Its lively acidity, delicate spice, and smooth, well-rounded profile come together to create a harmonious and captivating tasting experience. The wine's bright acidity provides lift and freshness, enhancing its complexity and showcasing the elegance typical of great Pinot Noir.

Appellation:

Russian River Valley, Eastern Hills Neighborhood

Unique Qualities of Vineyard/Location:

Following the western edge of the Mayacamas range, this northernmost neighborhood has the least fog influence. Soils may be the most diverse within the Valley and are both volcanic and sedimentary. The western facing vineyards along the hills are exposed to warm afternoon temperatures and grapes tend to ripen earlier.

Fermentation Details:

After the 5-7 days of cold soak the wine is inoculated. Then the wine goes through primary fermentation. Once the wine goes through fermentation in tank, we press it off and it gets moved to French oak barrels. Then the aging process begins.

Vertical, cordon spur trained
