Description

Living up to its older sibling's legacy, this award-winning wine has proven itself to be a stand-out Pinot Noir. Consisting of all Dijon clones and aged in new oak barrels, the 2017 Horseridge Pinot Noir has prominent wood elements that are well balanced by intense fruit and noticeable acidity. Enticing, yet complex aromas of apple, fig, blueberry, raspberry, rhubarb, and cigar envelop the nose. Flavors of chocolate raspberry torte are beautifully woven with tobacco while savory notes linger not too far behind, creating a well-rounded and elegant wine.
